## **ARTISTIC CV - Drag & Performance (Selected)**

Marilyn Nova White (they/them) is a Berlin-based, genderqueer performance artist, actor and Drag King with half-Bulgarian roots. Born into a working-class family with little access to art or culture, Marilyn grew into a full-blown stage creature – a shapeshifter whose interdisciplinary and autobiographical work explores queer embodiment, Drag, desire, heritage, identity, social norms, gender, and states of transition. Queer-feminist thought, sexual education, and elements of kink, pleasure and unpleasure inform Marilyn's artistic approach, always with a strong sense of humor.

Since 2017, as Drag King Marilyn Moustache, Marilyn has developed intimate, resistant, and creatively subversive performances where glam, trash, and comedy meet.

Since mid-2025, Marilyn is proudly represented by agency public heroes (Berlin) for acting, commercial work, and people casting.

#### **Performance Work & Artistic Development**

- Active in the international independent theatre and performance scene since 2012, after completing
  Theatre Pedagogy (BuT®) in Heidelberg the turning point after an early career in the medical and
  administrative fields.
- Artistic trajectory shaped through autodidactic learning, collective processes, and experimental, transdisciplinary creation methods.
- Performances include dance, text, song, bondage-based choreography, clowning, site-specific work, and improvisational dramaturgy.
